New Legislation



Renewable Transport Fuels and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Regulations 2018

These Regulations amend the Renewable Transport Fuel Obligations Order 2007, the Energy Act 2004 and the Motor Fuel (Road Vehicle and Mobile Machinery) Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Regulations 2012. They aim to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from fuels supplied in transport, thereby supporting the delivery of savings to meet UK carbon budgets. They also align UK schemes with requirements in EU legislation.

The Ionising Radiation (Basic Safety Standards) (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2018

This instrument transposes new requirements contained in the European Council Directive 2013/59/Euratom.

Most of the requirements of the Directive are already implemented in existing United Kingdom legislation. This Instrument is necessary to transpose new requirements contained in the Directive concerning public exposures that do not fit within existing regimes. The Directive also incorporates recommendations from the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP).

The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) is consulting on the proposed Marine Plan for Northern Ireland. When adopted, the plan will primarily be used by public authorities taking decisions which affect or might affect the marine area. It may also be used by anyone who has an interest in the marine area, including those bringing forward proposals and stakeholders who wish to comment on such proposals. You are invited to express your views on the proposed marine plan.

Pilot scheme offers farmers free environmental audit

A new pilot scheme aimed at improving the environment, reducing the number of on-farm inspections and helping farmers comply with payment rules has been launched by the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA). By identifying and tackling minor environmental issues around the farm and addressing them promptly, the aim is to improve the environment and at the same time reduce the chances of cross compliance inspections and breaches.

Regulatory Position Statement – Duty of Care Responsibilities for farmers


