oise Directive 92002/49/EC (END) aims to avoid, prevent and reduce, on a prioritised basis, the harmful effects, including annoyance, resulting from e This Directive was transposed in Northern Ireland by the Environmental Noise Regulations (NI) 2006 which require noise mapping to be undertaken e . Action Plans, to deal with priority areas on noise pollution, are then drafted based on the Noise MAPS. This consultation deals with the third round o Noise Action Plan follows the approach set out in the Department's Technical Guidance on Noise Mapping and Action Planning issued in 2013, and ch DAERA/NIEA can comply with the requirements of the END. The Action Plan analyses the results of the noise mapping in terms of the area, numb exposed to various levels of noise.
